Gunnersbury Park, Hydrological Restoration (Construction Phase)

Gunnersbury Park is a 72ha park of mature trees, open grass land and historic buildings, located in the Hounslow Borough of London. The Park is registered by English Heritage as Grade II* making it one of the top 30% of Registered Parks and Gardens in the country, containing 22 Grade II* and Grade II listed buildings. It is bordered by the North Circular to the East, the M4 and Kensington Cemetery to the South, and housing to the North and West; its northern and western boundaries border the London Borough of Ealing.

Following assisting in the preparation of a design for a successful HLF bid, Stirling Maynard were appointed to provide construction stage support to the Client.



Responsibilities of Stirling Maynard include:

- Review of Contractor design elements and liaising with Contractor and Client to ensure that a suitable solution is reached that meets the original requirements
- Further investigation into existing pond construction following drain-down and de-silting works.
- Evaluation of options for repair of Round Pond
- Specification and supervision of geotechnical testing and topographic surveying to inform the decision making process.
- Amending and adding detail to the design to take account of discoveries made within the construction phase
- Liaison with Contractor and Architects regarding Horseshoe Pond and Middle Bridge interfaces.
- General site support services and regular site inspections
